My Soul Finds Rest in God Alone

- Today J: Come, w/b. Don't know re you; but lately been feeling pretty w/b; sad, fatgd, exhstd, w/b. I see so much pain; wears on me. I know ppl: dying slow/painful dth, & all fam can do, watch hap; lost loved ones (prnt, spouse, chld, frnd), miss them; really sick, suffrng in pain; marg crumblng, on brink divrc; surrndd by violnc, live in fear; going thru crisis/faith, doubtng God's love; feel abandoned bec fam/frnds turning backs on them; just beaten down, crushed, stressed, lonely, sad, w/b. I doubt that any you going thru all these trbls all at once. But I'm sure all you have suffered painful life exprncs, and you know what it's like feel w/b.
- Know smthg: J does too. In vss right before, ppl calling J glutton/drnkrd simply for minstring to hurting ppl. They made fun; tried kill; did kill; made fun while killing. And J came be Sav of a wrld that hates him. So yes, J knows what like to feel w/b.
- He uses pic/yoke. **Take my yoke upon you.** Know what yoke? Yoke: woodn crssbeam farmers put over neck/shldrs oxen. Connctd to plow behind; and oxen'd push forwrd w/all strngth vs yoke to pull plow, till field. I'm sure hard work, hvy burdn on shlders. To use diff pic, think carryng great big hvy bckpck, filled w/hvy supplies, weighng down on shlders. Hard carry, exhstng, yoke that leaves w/b.
- Well, which hith concrns, dth loved ones, crmbing marg, crmbing frndshps, crisis/faith, stress, sadness, or hrtache of any kind that is weighing you down, where going find rest? Today, to you/me, evone who feels beaten down, J: vs. 28. So we can say w/hymnwrtr: MSFRGA. Vs. 28. I think this one most beautfl psgs in all Scrptr. It's really: invitnt fr J; he's invtng us to let him take that yoke, hvy bckpck of burdns, off our shiders, and give us some much-needed rest!
- I bet you know what like need rest? Smtms just need sleep (eyes can't stay open another min). Smtms just need sit down, take break fr work (when don't have 1 ounce/enrgy left in you). Smtms need vaca (got get away, see some scenery, have some fun). We all need rest! And God: one who inventd rest! After 6 days/creatn, restd on 7th; called it Sab Day (word means rest). And it's not as if God was tuckered out! But he was setting pattern for us: first work, then rest. So God commndd his ppl, on Sab, take break, get rest: phys rest fr labor (yes, of course); but also sprtl rest, time spent in GW & worship rest for body & for soul! J: vs. 29ac. And Ps 62, which sang earlier, which basis of hymn just sang and title of this sermon: "Truly my soul finds rest in God; my salvtn comes from him. Yes, my soul, find rest in God. Truly he is my rock and my salvtn" (1,5,6). MSFRGA!
- So when you feeling w/b, dump burdns on J. That's what invts/wants you do, so can find true sprtl rest. And it can be burdn of hrtache/pain; or can be burden of sin/guilt. Can be burden knowing that sinful culture in which you live, and sinful nature which lives in you, have frequtly gotten best/you & brought out worst/you. Burden knowing you've said/done things: contrry faith/values as Xian, contrry God's will for your life, contrry to kind/prsn you want be. Burden realizing you've behvd like citizen/wild, not as citizen/kingdm/God or chld/God. We disappnt Lord & selves when say/think/do evil—and that's heavy burden for our souls bear! And we all know the weight! So where can we find peace/rest for souls? J: vs. 28. MSFRGA, bec J has taken that heaviest bckpck sin/guilt off your shldrs, & thrown his shlders; carried your evil to cross, & crucfd it there; unlatchd you fr that yoke crushing down on you. And he forgives you, for evthing! And proms you rest for soul, here earth, and best rest of all: etrnl rest, w/J forever in hvn. MSFRGA!
- Vs. 29a, 30. So not only does J take off our old yoke/sin; also replaces w/new yoke, his yoke. So what is this yoke/J, & why want wear it? Thght yoke was burden. No, yoke/J is yoke/discplshp. Good thing! Discplshp means follwng/belvng in J as his disc; and disc is stdnt/tr, smone who learns fr instrctr. So as follwrs/bels/J, we: his discs/stdnts; J wants us learn fr him. Why says: vs. 29a. So wearing this yoke/discplchp means sitting at J's feet, as a stdnt, listning Word, devourng evthng he has say, bec J's Word/Gos is what gives us sprtl rest. Means coming ch faithfully, making that top priority for entire life. Means studying Word in a Bible class or reading Word in home w/fam. That is dscplshp. And what a blessing/privldg is: be disc/J, learn fr him!

- Vs. 29a,b. Nowhere is that more evidnt than at cross. "As sheep before its shearers is silent" says Isa (53:7), J willingly, w/o resistance allowed self suffer terrible evil at hand/men, in order redeem us. J humbly submtd to Fr's will, out of unfthmbl love for you/me. And that's what wants you know/learn bec more you know/bel this, the more vs. 29c.
- But not evbdy gets it. At beg/psg, J: vs. 25-26. These "wise/learnd" ppl: too smart for J; think know better than he does; follow own logic, make selves the god they trust in; self-sufficnt. Little chldrn on other hand (which, by way: nothing do w/age) realize not self-sufficnt; do need J. Trust/J w/chldlike faith (humble, honest, sincere, unquestnng); they undrstnd kngdm/God, bec God reveals it to them thru HS! You/I: these little chldrn, no matter how old, if trust/J w/chldlike faith. "Unless you change and become like little chldrn, you will nvr enter kingdom/hvn" (Mt 18:3). J loves to call Xians lowly ppl like in Beattds; blessed: poor in spirit, meek, merciful. Here, we: the little chldrn.
- And that's smthng we really need take to hrt! We are God's little chldrn by faith. We have Fr who loves us, Br who died/rose for us. We need learn truly trust in J (w/simple, humble, confdnt, childlike faith), no matter chllngs we face, no matter trbls we see arnd us bec J says vs. 28. Where you going find rest for weary soul when: surrounded by sickness/death; feel lonely/abandoned; when marg is crumblng and frndshps falling apart; when feel guilt/sins; when heart is brkn and just feel beaten down, w/b where going find rest?
- "My soul finds rest in God alone, my rock and my salvation; a fortress strong against my foes, and I will not be shaken" (CW 818:1). "Truly my soul finds rest in God; my salvtn comes from him. Yes, my soul, find rest in God. Truly he is my rock and my salvtn" (Ps 62:1,5,6). Whatever heavy bckpck you're carrying, whatever burdnsome yoke you're bearing, today J: vs. 28. I forgive you, I love you, I care re you, I have saved you, I am w/you, I will guide you, I will never leave you, I will always be there for you. Want proof? Look: at cross, empty tomb, baptsml cert. I am committed to you forever. Vs. 29. MSFRGA.
