Fall MAP Schedule

Our 3rd through 8th graders will be working on three different standardized tests during September 23-27. We are planning to take the tests during Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday. These math, reading, and language arts tests from NWEA MAPS help to identify student's individual areas of strength or weakness. This year, classroom teachers will also use the results to help each of these students with individualized learning and practice. Using the online service from "Study Island", teachers will connect the MAPS test results throughout the year to help students where they most need a boost.

K-2 Sing

The kindergarten through 2nd grade classes will sing at the September 22, 8:00 AM church service. Each child may sit with their family and come up front to sing as a group. Our kids will be singing the opening song for the worship service.
